Rosehill Christian School was founded in 1990. Prior to 1990, Rosehill Christian School was a ministry of Boys' and Girls' Country in Hockley, Texas. Mr. and Mrs. T.A. Robinson founded a Christian school on their campus to minister to the students who lived at Boys' and Girls' Country. Students from the surrounding community were invited to enroll as well. Rosehill Christian School and its new Board were allowed to rent buildings on the Boys' and Girls' Country campus for two years. Finally, the school was faced with having to provide their own facilities. A board member stepped out by faith and placed money down on fifteen acres located about six miles west of Tomball, Texas, on FM 2920.
